2015 Program Highlights

- **Noincrease** in the payrollmultiplier used to calculate employer subscription fees or to the minimum(\$1,050) or maximum (\$8,450) annual fees.
- Effective April1, EMC Insurance was added as a Sponsoring Insurance Provider, offering a 5%premium credit to our members.
- Effective August1, IBEW Local #343 (Southern MN) joined the Program.
- As a 501 C (9)non-profit Labor-Management Trust, the UCWCP is audited annually. Once again, we received the highest-level opinion on our audited financial statements from the Fund's Auditor.
- The TrustAgreement was amended pertaining to Trustee Appointing Authority.
 ForManagement trustees, new associations were given appointing authority.
 ForLabor trustees, a ranking method using the number of participating members bytrade will determine selection. The board now has 24 trustees total.
- 2015ended with 339 participating contractors employing 18,100 trades-people earning\$947 million in annual field payroll-- increase of \$89 million from the end of2014.
- Conducted 37Facilitations, 23 Mediations, 0 Arbitrations and 32 Neutral Physician Exams.
- Added a mediator to the panel William Pederson who served as a judge on the MN Workers' Compensation of Appeals for 14 years.
- In 2015, the EPO Nominations and Review Committee analyzed: Primary Care –
 Occupational Medicine and Family Practice; Specialty Care Neurosurgery and
 Orthopedic Surgery. The reviews identified the most appropriate providers for the
 EPO and increased useful information for each doctor or facility.
